

## Class Reminders

Below is a list of helpful reminders when taking a class at the Sacramento State Aquatic Center

**Location:** Classes are held at the Sacramento State Aquatic Center located on Lake Natoma at 1901 Hazel Ave., Gold River, CA 95670.

Note: All Water Ski / Jet Ski / Wakeboarding classes meet at the Sacramento State Aquatic Center and are transported to Folsom Lake unless other arrangements are made.

**Refund Policy:** There are no refunds unless a class is cancelled. Classes are cancelled if the minimum enrollment is not met.

**Transfer to Another Class:** Transferring classes may be done if the request is received at least 5 working days before your scheduled class. There is a \$10 processing fee for all transfers.

**Attendance:** Please be on time for all class meetings. When coming to the first class meeting, please check in at the front office. The front office will take care of your remaining balance and proper paperwork and inform you where to go from there.

**Failure to Attend:** There are no make-up sessions if you miss a class. Failure to attend a class in which you are registered will result in forfeiting the deposit. Hardship cases will be dealt with on an individual basis.

**Clothing:** Wear comfortable clothing that you do not mind getting wet. Bring a towel for the days that you will be in the water. Wear old tennis shoes, aqua socks, or sandals that wrap around the ankle (i.e. Tevas). Please do not wear jewelry or bring anything of value.

**Swim Test:** There will be a mandatory swim test on the first class meeting. The distance of this test is approximately 150 feet. The purpose of this test is to evaluate your swimming ability. A life vest may be worn for this swim test. The Aquatic Center will supply a wetsuit for chilly days. A swim test is not done for the Water Ski, Wakeboard, or Jet Ski classes. Water Ski, Wakeboard, and Jet Ski participants must be capable swimmers and will wear a life vest at all times when in/on/near water.
