

SUMMER YOUTH AQUATIC CAMP

What to expect...

Monday Morning Check-In:

Check in will be located at our new administration building on the west side of the property between 7:30 am and 8:30 am. Please be patient when waiting for your child to be checked in. We need to check in every child individually to make sure that they are properly placed in a group. We try to be as fast and efficient as possible however you should still allow extra time on Monday morning.

To help the morning run more smoothly, parents can do the following:

- Make sure your child has already applied their sun block and they are prepared with a lunch and **plenty of water**.
- Have the camp balance paid ahead of time. We require that the balance is paid one week prior to camp.
- Make sure that summer camp packets are filled out **completely**. The release form must be signed and emergency phone numbers, contacts and medical information must be complete.

Once your child has been placed with a counselor:

- Pick up a Sac State Aquatic Center camp t-shirt.
- Pick up your Aqua Smart visor (they float and are great in the water).
- Pick up your **California Department of Boating & Waterways Boating Safety Book**.***
- Have your child's picture taken in their Sac State Aquatic Center camp T-shirt.
- Find your counselor. Their names are painted on the picnic tables inside the Aquatic Center compound.
- Put your ice chest and gear bags on summer camp selves. Water skier's gear goes to the ski boathouse.

Daily:

After the first day, you will need to check your children in and out each day. Camp begins promptly at 8:30 am. If they are not here, we will call you. If you know that they will be late or missing a day, please let us know at (916) 278-2842

Ice cream is sold daily from 3:30 pm – 4:00 pm (\$1.00 - \$1.75).

Check-Out:

Camp instruction and clean up is over at 3:30 pm. Checkout is between 3:30 pm and 4:00 pm at the inner circle drive. Children must be checked out by 5:00 pm. **Your child must be signed out every afternoon.** The campers are not allowed to leave on their own or wait at the front of the Aquatic Center alone. This is for their safety! If your child is in a carpool we must have written permission.

Parents Night:

On Thursday at 3:30 pm we are looking forward to seeing you for Parent's Night! This is a chance for your child to show off some of their newly acquired skills. Bring a bathing suit and go sailing, windsurfing, canoeing or kayaking with your child.

**** We are asking that parents help read a chapter a night in the boating safety books. We realize that there is a lot of material that may be difficult for children to understand. We hope that if parents help their children, the entire family will become more water safe. There is a test that comes with the book and if the child passes the test, the California Department of Boating & Waterways will send them a California Boating Safety Certificate. Some boating insurance companies give up to a 20% discount for this certification. Our goal is to make boating a safe and fun experience!*
