SUMMARY:

The Summer Camp – Youth Instructor shall handle the daily operations for youth programs at the Aquatic Center. The primary area of responsibility is to teach boating safety to children ages 7-17.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

Learn and become proficient in sailing, windsurfing, canoeing, kayaking and boating safety.

You will be responsible for 10-15 children per week and will teach these skills to each child.

Check-in and check-out of campers is required on daily basis. Monday-Friday 7:30am-4:30pm daily

Facility and equipment cleaning is required on a daily basis.

You may be required to be on-call for certain shifts or special events

Other duties may be assigned.
